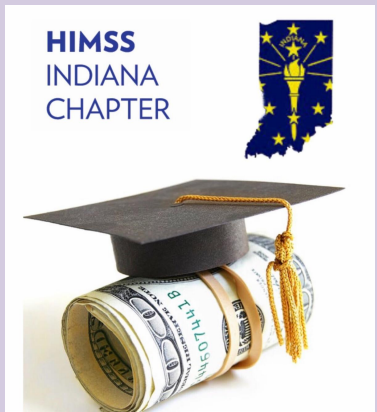

Scholarship Program

Purpose: To provide financial assistance and recognition to qualified students in accredited programs in health management, health information technology, management programs with a health focus, or technology programs with a focus in healthcare information technology.

Objective: Present two (2) scholarship awards to deserving applicants who are attending accredited programs while enrolled in a program affiliated with an Indiana-based academic institution.

Program Structure:

A two thousand five hundred-dollar scholarships (\$2,500) will be offered to two selected students. One in a graduate program (to include Master or Doctorate) and the other in an undergraduate program. Recipients will be provided with a complimentary student membership in the Indiana Chapter of HIMSS (Additional value of \$30) and be able to attend HIMSS Indiana Chapter sponsored events at no cost.
